#### Can Craft



## Materials:

- · Empty, clean can
- · Mod Podge®
- · Tissue Paper
- Brush
- String
- Nail
- Hammer
- Small Stick
- Bird Food

### Directions:

- 1. Remove outside label from can.
- 2. Grab desired colors of tissue paper and rip them into small or large pieces.
- 3. Grab a brush and apply a layer Mod Podge® on can, lay tissue paper, apply another layer of Mod Podge® over tissue paper.
- 4. Repeat steps until you have the desired amount of tissue paper on can.
- 5. Allow 24 hours for the can to dry.
- 6. Glue a stick or a long piece of wood on the inside of the can.
- 7. Allow 24 hours for wood to dry.
- 8. Use nail and hammer to nail a hole on the bottom of the can\*\*
- 9. Insert string through the hole and tie to the other side.
- 10. Fill with bird food and hang from desired spot outside.
- 11. Watch the birds enjoy!

Tip: Use a smooth edge can opener to ensure there are not sharp edges.
